- 4. What was the political situation in Rwanda upon independence in 1962?
- 5. What precipitated the violence that began in April 1994?
- 6. How was the attempted genocide carried out? Characteristics?
- 7. When the killing stopped, what was the resulting political situation?
- 8. What was outside/international reaction to the Rwandan crisis? Where there any attempts to intervene?
